- Members of the club actively participate in the project (not just write a check)
- Project falls into one of The Rotary Foundation's seven areas of focus
- Club partners with a local community organization (such as school system, local nonprofit, government agency, etc.)

SECOND CRITERION FOR THE AWARD

Club shares details about the Local Community Service Project referenced in the First Criterion on Rotary Showcase (an online site that is part of the Rotary.org website)

THIRD CRITERION FOR THE AWARD

Club publicizes the Local Community Service Project referenced in the First Criterion via two types of media:

- One or more print (newspaper, magazine, etc.) or broadcast media (radio, TV)
- Social Media (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc.)

FOURTH CRITERION FOR THE AWARD

Club holds 2 programs dealing with Local Community Service

- Each program falls into a different area of focus, so that 2 areas of focus are addressed in total
- Each program is presented by a different local community organization
